

## SoP for In-Campus Admission

Programme Name: M Tech in (a) Computer Science and Engineering (b) Energy Engineering

### Important Dates

The counselling and Admission schedule for Admission into the In-campus M Tech programmes are as follows;

#### For GATE Qualified candidates

#### Note:

- The eligible GATE qualified candidates as per merit list 1 must strictly reach the venue before reporting time as mentioned for completing the admission process. Failure to attend the counselling, the seats will be allotted to the next eligible candidates as per the merit list.
- In case of any emergency, if the eligible GATE qualified candidates fail to report on time, they may be allowed for counselling process subjected to the availability of seats. They will be allowed for counselling process only after completion of the admission process for Day 1.

#### For Non-GATE candidates:

The Non-GATE candidates must have to appear the ASTU M Tech Entrance Examination 2026.

Note: After admission of GATE qualified candidates, the remaining seats will be filled up from ASTU M Tech Entrance Examination 2026. The short-listed candidates of ASTU M Tech Entrance Examination 2026 for admission in M Tech programmes will be published on the university website based on the availability of vacant seats.

### Eligibility:

#### For Computer Science Engineering:

Admission Procedure/Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must have eligible BE/B.Tech. degree (Computer Science and Engineering or Information Technology or Electronics and Communication Engineering or Electrical and Electronics Engineering) or MCA or M.Sc. (Information Technology or Computer Science) with a minimum of 50% marks (45% for ST and SC) in aggregate (or equivalent CGPA) or equivalent.
- Candidates waiting for last semester BE/ B Tech results in the abovementioned branches may also apply, but will have to submit the required documents within a stipulated period to be specified by the selection committee.
- Candidates with valid GATE score in the above-mentioned branches will be preferred and admitted on merit basis (as per GATE score).
- The remaining vacant seats will be filled up through the university entrance examination ASTU M Tech Entrance Examination 2026.

## For Energy Engineering:

### Admission Procedure/Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must have eligible BE/B.Tech degree in Chemical/ Mechanical/ Electrical/ Energy/ Electronics/ Instrumentation/ Agricultural Engineering and other relevant disciplines with a minimum of 50% marks (45% for ST and SC) in aggregate (or equivalent CGPA).
- Candidates waiting for last semester BE/ B Tech results in the above-mentioned branches may also apply, but will have to submit the required documents within a stipulated period to be specified by the selection committee.
- Candidates with valid GATE score in the above-mentioned branches will be preferred and admitted on merit basis (as per GATE score).
- The remaining vacant seats will be filled up through the university entrance examination ASTU M Tech Entrance Examination 2026.

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION

1. Candidates are required to bring the following documents in original along with self-attested photocopies at the time of counselling process:
  - Printout of the completed online application form.
  - Receipt of application fee payment
  - Valid GATE score card (as applicable).
  - Marksheets and Certificates of Academic Qualifications from HSLC (10th std) onwards
  - Proof of Date of Birth (DOB).
  - Migration certificate (as applicable).
  - Anti-ragging affidavit.
  
  - Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS and other categories)
  - Aadhaar Card or any other valid Government-issued Photo Identity Card.
  - Recent passport-size colour photographs (3 copies).
  - Any other document(s) as specified by the University at the time of admission.
2. Candidates are required to pay the prescribed fee immediately after the counselling process to confirm the allotment of the seat. No seat shall be allotted unless the requisite fee is paid.
3. If a candidate fails to pay the prescribed fee immediately after the counselling process, the allotted seat shall be offered to the next eligible candidate in the merit list. No subsequent claim for the forfeited seat shall be entertained.
4. Statutory Reservation and Relaxation Policy shall be followed as per the Government Rules.
5. The admission and seat allotment shall be confirmed only after the candidate produces valid proof of fee payment at the designated verification counter.
6. Refund of fee as per "University fee refund Policy" as available in the university official website [www.astu.ac.in](http://www.astu.ac.in)
7. No cash payment shall be accepted under any circumstances. Candidates must make the payment only through the prescribed online payment mode.
8. The list of selected candidates for counselling/admission will be notified in the university website <https://www.astu.ac.in/>.
9. The selected candidates must have to produce the original testimonials and certificates at the time of counselling/admission.
